and Merry Mouse, I've heard.

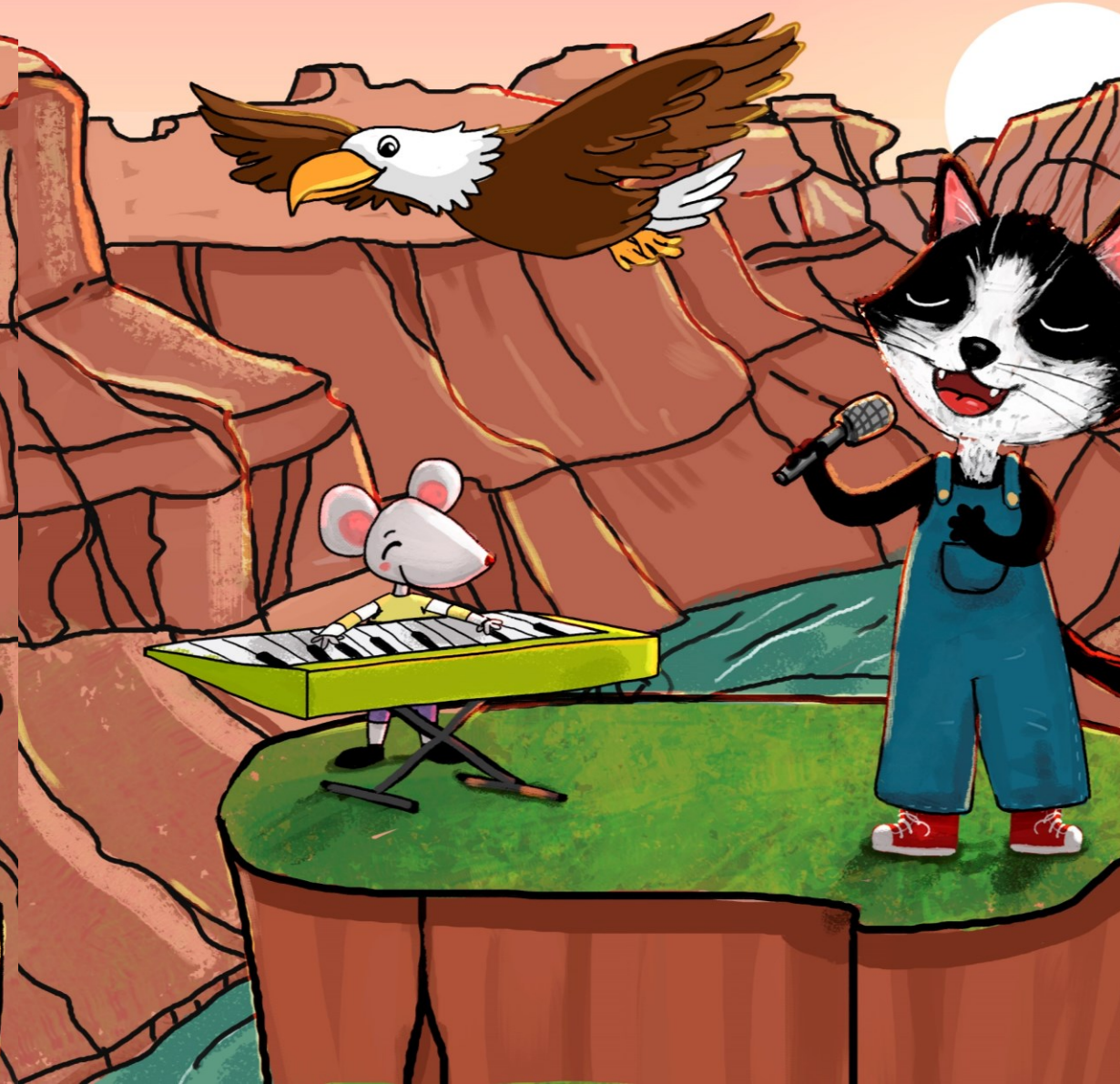
These magic musicians are on

Is the very tip of the great curling Grand Canyon.

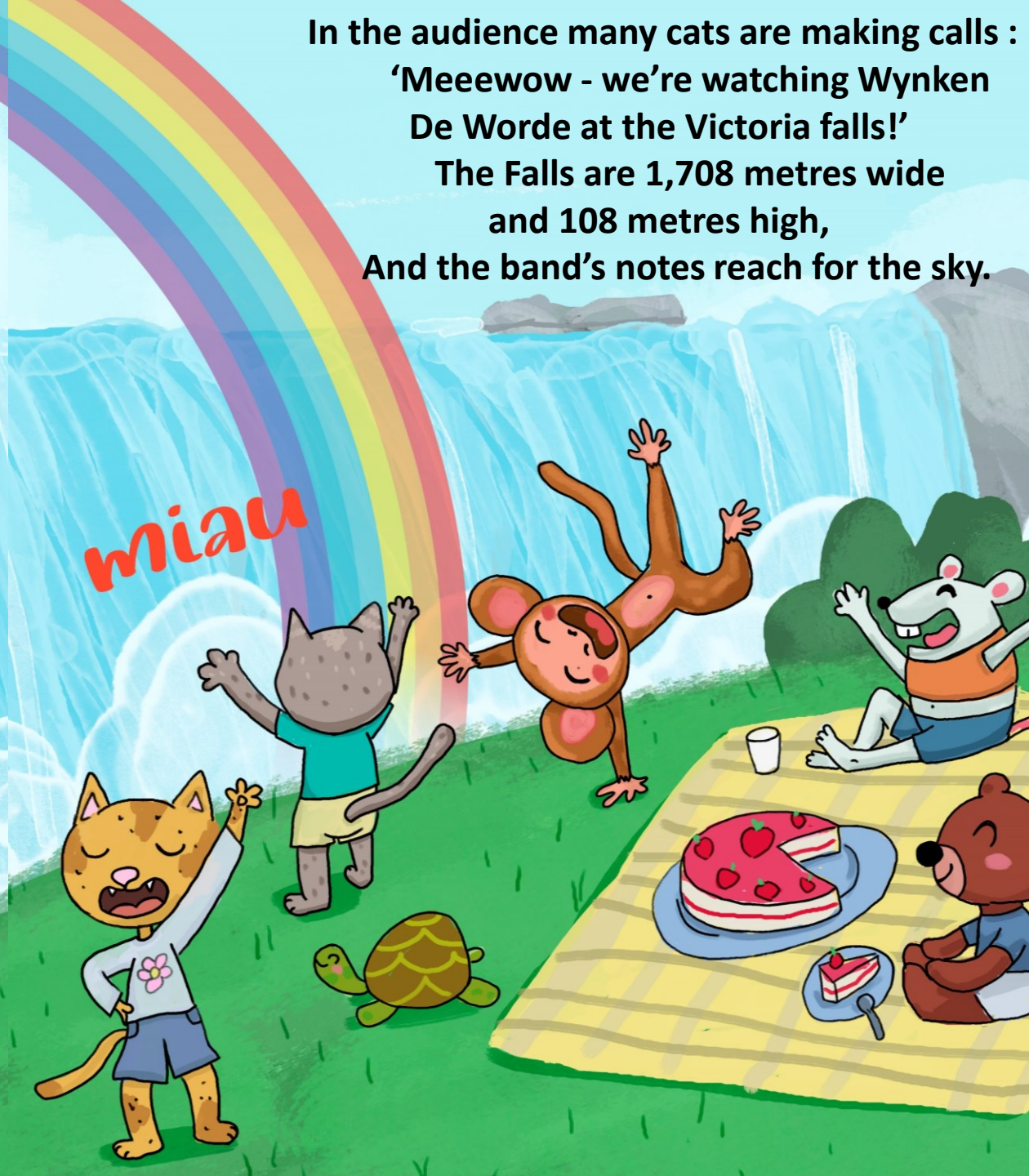


A natural sensation that is 6,000 feet deep, 277 mi

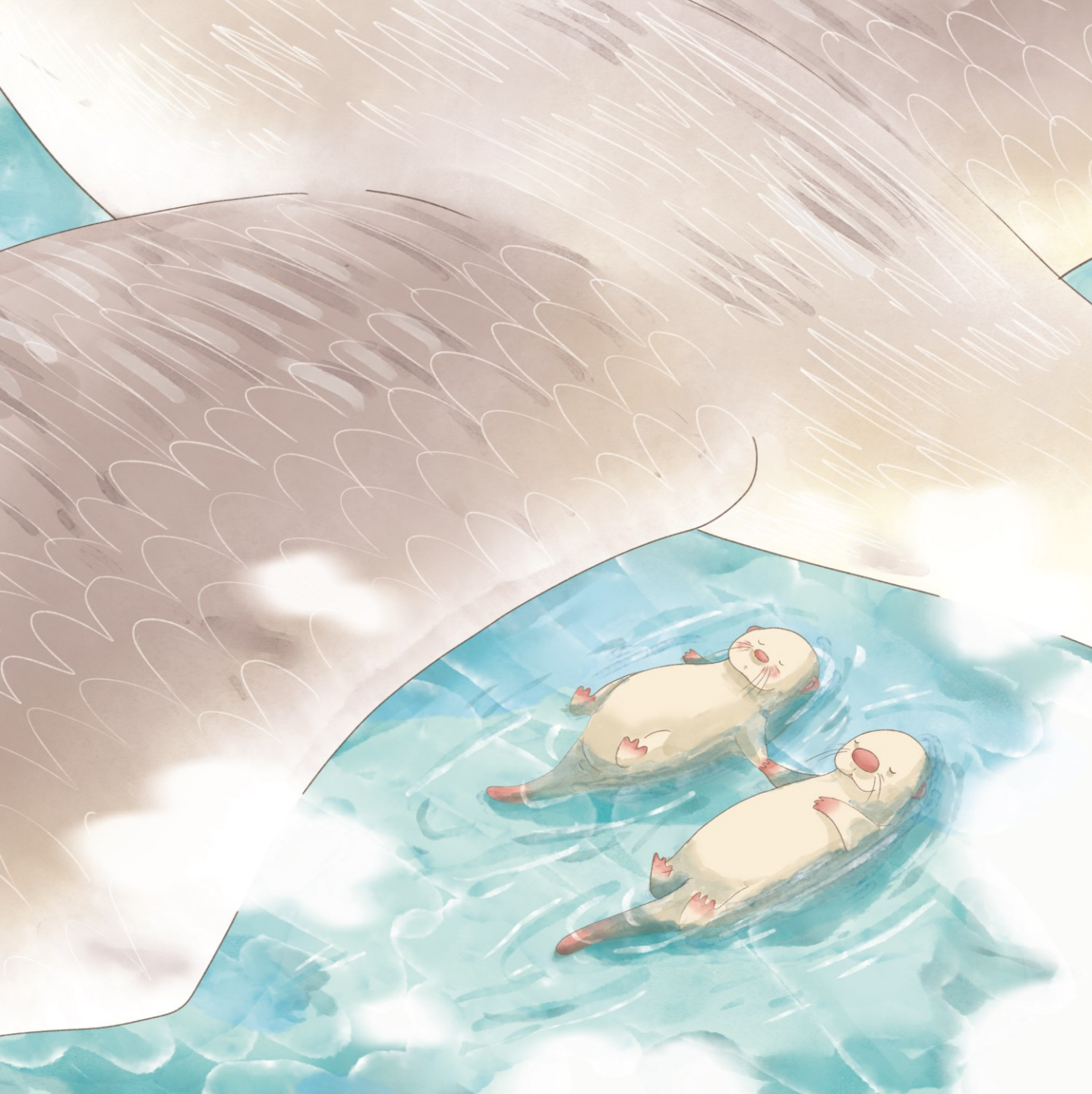

can fly.



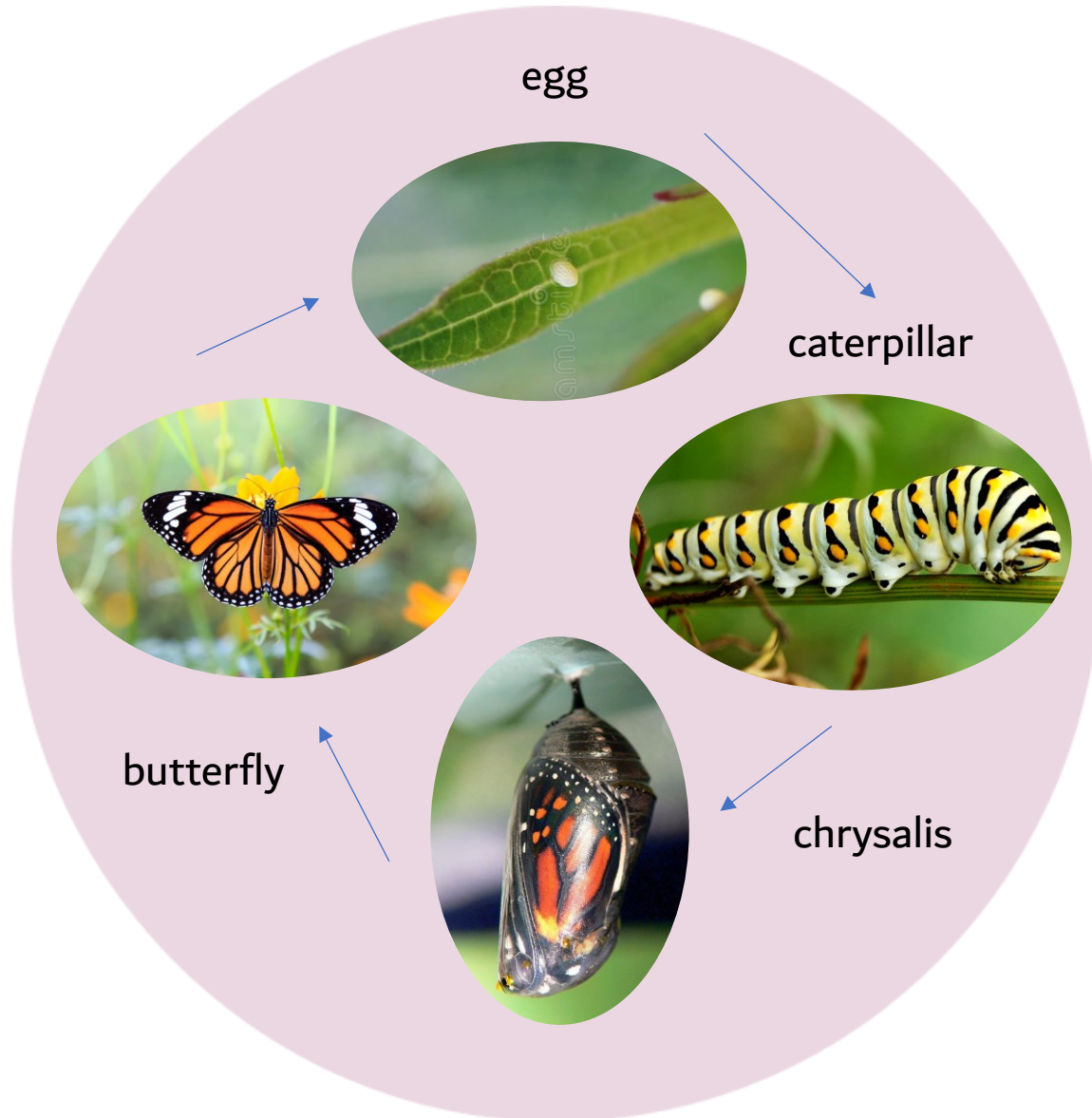


'Meta' means to change
